Day 1: Sunday, October 14, 2018 New Orleans, Louisiana - Tour Begins Step back in time on a cultural getaway that opens in the “Jazz Capital of the World” – New Orleans! This soulful city abounds with rich history, mouthwatering Cajun and Creole cuisine, and an incomparable soundtrack.

Day 2: Monday, October 15, 2018 Choose French Quarter Walking Tour or Motorcoach Tour of New Orleans The choice is yours!

Take a walking tour of New Orleans’ famous French Quarter where you’ll see the majestic St. Louis Cathedral, one of the city’s most recognizable landmarks; continue to the bustling French Marketplace where you’ll explore Pirates Alley, the Cabildo, the Presbytere and the Pontalba. Following dinner, **enjoy a jazz revue** at a local French Quarter jazz club. (B, D)

Day 3: Tuesday, October 16, 2018 New Orleans Journey through Louisiana’s swamp on a cruise* narrated by your captain. Learn about the history and ecology of this fascinating ecosystem while keeping an eye out for wildlife including bald eagles, herons, turtles and alligators! Return to New Orleans and spend the remainder of the afternoon at leisure to discover this great city your way. (B)

Day 4: Wednesday, October 17, 2018 New Orleans - Memphis, Tennessee Travel north to Memphis, the birthplace of the Blues, Rock ‘n’ Roll and Soul. Enter Elvis’ 14-acre estate and visit his home, original business office, trophy building with exhibits depicting Elvis’ life at Graceland, racquetball building, and the Meditation Garden, where Elvis and members of his family have been laid to rest. The remainder of your day is free to enjoy this city’s vast musical offerings on your own. Day 6: Friday, October 19, 2018 Memphis - Nashville Journey to the “Music Capital of the World” – Nashville. Relive days gone by during a **tour of the sprawling Belle Meade Plantation** and indulge in a culinary and wine tasting experience featuring southern delicacies.** This evening, **take your reserved seat at the renowned Grand Ole Opry.***** What began as a building where a local radio broadcast show aired once a week in 1925 has grown to become an entertainment complex that attracts music fans from all over the world. Day 7: Saturday, October 20, 2018 Nashville Your day begins with a local guide who will share the history and lore of Music City during a sightseeing tour where you will view the State Capitol, Music Row and the Parthenon — a full replica of the Athenian original! Next,
